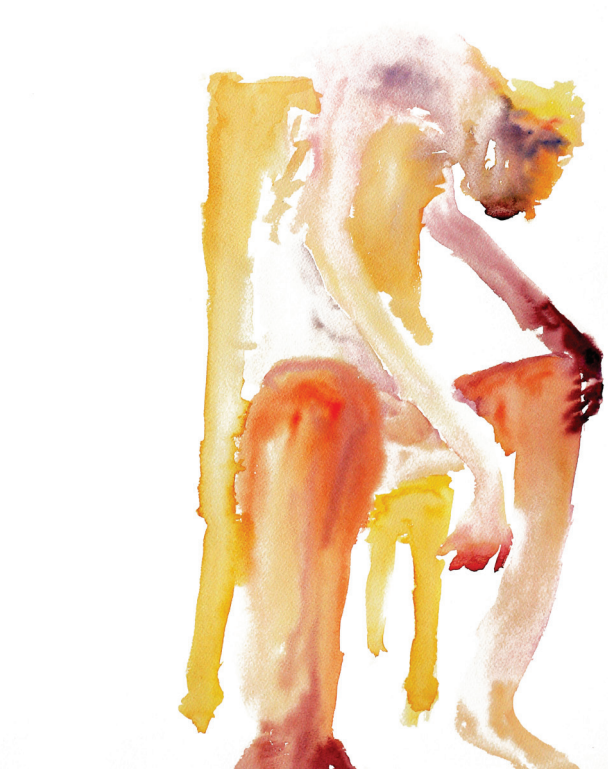

On Friday 28th November PS Art Space, Fremantle will launch Jacob Bayne's inaugural solo exhibition HUMAN TRACES.

Jacob has spent the past three years studying the human form, fascinated by the subconscious information we pick up through body language.

HUMAN TRACES is a collection of honest, abstract depictions of what is commonly recognisable. Created using a mix of rice paper, ink and watercolor, Bayne's haunting images emerge and seep through layers of paper, leaving behind shadows and traces of emotionally charged forms.

*'I explore the emotion of human movement, shadows and shape, inviting the viewer to interpret the body language of the remnants left behind'* Bayne explains.

PS Art Space is a large warehouse gallery space where Jacob will display life size images, some of the figures illuminated to highlight the layers of colour and brush strokes traces.

Even larger images will dominate the main gallery wall, whilst hundreds of smaller images will give an insight into his thought and creative process.

Jacob Bayne is a resident artist at PS Art Studios since February 2014.
